



Event Attendant Safety Instructions

The attendant for an event is a very important individual. You are there to insure the safety of the children using the equipment. Nobody wants to see anyone get hurt and it is very easy for a young child to get a little excited and without realizing it, do something that can cause injury to themselves or to others. The following are guidelines for ensuring the safe use of a Bounce House at a special event.

1. Never walk away from the equipment.
2. Make sure that the children do not take anything into the Bounce House that they shouldn't.
3. Users must remove their shoes.
4. Absolutely no sharp object such as eyeglasses, keys, pencils and pens, sharp belt buckles are allowed inside the unit.
5. No silly string at all. (*Damage to the fire retardant used on the unit may result*).
6. No candy inside the unit.
7. No face-paint inside the unit. (*causes permanent stains*)
8. No food or drinks allowed inside the unit.
9. No water inside or around a dry unit. (*Mold and damage to the threading may result*).
10. Do not allow children to hang from the netting.
11. No ruff housing.
12. Keep children in separate age groups. See chart below.
13. Do not let anyone play near the blower. (*Possible electric shock.*)
14. Children under the age of three should be accompanied by an adult.
15. Never exceed the capacity as shown on the unit being utilized.
16. Should the power go out, your first responsibility is to get the children out safely.
