



## Preparing for the Bounce House

The day has arrived and your bouncer is here. The delivery driver is at the door and you're jumper is ready to be set up, but your yard isn't ready. We run into this all the time. Things that need to be done such as making sure the path to the setup location is clear. Cleaning up after your pets and that your sprinkler system was turned off the night before.

Access to the yard must be free and clear of any obstacles. Navigating through someone's side yard when the trashcans and bicycles are in the way can be hazardous especially if you are trying to support a 350 pound bounce house on a dolly.

The drivers will not set up a unit in a yard that has not been cleaned. If you own pets your yard should be thoroughly cleaned the day before and watered down to remove any animal feces from the surface of your grass. You and your guest will appreciate it. Our drivers will not set up a unit in a yard that has not been cleaned prior to their arrival. We offer the following as a quick checklist that can be used prior to your party equipment arriving.

- Turn off automatic sprinklers the night before your party.
- Clear hazards from the yard entry point.
- Move any children's play toys and/or yard toys prior to delivery.
- Clean up any animal mess and hose down the lawn.
- Trim any overhanging limbs that may come into contact with the Jumper.
- If your set up is on the driveway broom sweep the area.
- Cleanup any oil or hazardous material from the driveway.

Our drivers are often making as many as six to seven deliveries on a Saturday or Sunday morning, they really don't have much time when making a delivery. They are not allowed to move items that are in the way of a setup. This causes delays in our schedules and may cause us to be late to the next delivery, which could be your party and we would not want that to occur.

Should you not be ready to accept delivery the drivers will need to go on to the next delivery and return to make your delivery at a later time. Although this is rare it does happen.
